Job Description

Four County Mental Health Center, Inc. has been an area provider of public mental health services since 1964. Historically, being the designated community mental health clinic meant that citizens of each county had access to only two services: Outpatient counseling and psychiatric/medication services. Over the past several years, our scope has increased to include more than 40 service programs designed to meet the unique needs associated with all ages and mental/behavioral health challenges.

Assertive Community Treatment Peer Support Specialist –The ACT Peer Support Specialist is an integral part of a multi-disciplinary team of mental health clinicians. This position provides a voice of lived experience while helping clients to identify a path to his/her recovery. The ACT Peer Support Specialist will be expected to manage his/her own schedule and will also be expected to work in a team environment that includes daily team meetings. The vast majority of services will take place in client's home and/or in the community. Must have a High School Diploma or GED and a minimum of 2 years personal life experience of receiving Behavioral Health Services.

• Hourly position: starting wage is \$32,672.00/year – 15.71/hour. (Full-Time)

Kids Konnections Attendant Care- This position consists of working one-on-one in a home-like setting with children ages 6 to 18 years old on the weekends. Staff will be responsible for care of and activities for the child, while maintaining safety. We are seeking individuals who enjoy working with children, whom are flexible, dependable and would like to earn extra money while doing something rewarding!

• Starting wage is \$15.71hour. (Part-Time Weekends).

Crisis Diversion Services Therapist On-Call – Position entails serving on an on-call rotation as needed, providing emergency services for both adults and children in the agency catchment area. Ability to provide excellent customer service to agency business partners and patients is a must. Added benefits for this position include: Enhanced salary rate for on-call coverage periods, opportunity for incentive pay and extra days off each month. Requires a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work, counseling, psychology, or marriage and family therapy. Potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas.

• Wage is: \$40.00/hour (Full Time and PRN)

Therapist Mobile Crisis Response Back up On-Call-

This position is designed to provide comprehensive mobile emergency services in community settings with primary emphasis on crisis intervention, stabilizing, and safety planning. This person will work closely with community partners who serve mutual clients, coordinate services, monitor staff availability, approve clinical documentation, and gather and provide data required by MCR model. Requires a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work, psychology, or marriage and family therapy. Potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas. Two years of clinical experience in outpatient mental health services with one year experience in crisis work preferred.

• Starting wage is \$73,500/year (salary does include a \$2,000 stipend for on-call). (Hours are 11:00AM-9:00PM four days per week.)

Outpatient Therapist-

This therapist is responsible for providing mental health treatment services and providing consultation services to individuals and organizations in the community. Requires a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work, psychology, or marriage and family therapy. Potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas. Applicants with additional addictions licensure (LAC, LCAC) are encouraged to apply, but this is not a requirement.

• Starting wage is \$71,500/year. Applicants willing to provide dual-diagnosis services could receive an additional increase of \$2,000. Sign-on bonus available. (Full-Time)

Clinical Services Therapist- Children and Family-

This therapist is responsible for providing mental health and/or SUD treatment services to children and families (individual, family, and group therapy) within the scope of their license; and providing consultation services to individuals and organizations in the community. Requires a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work, psychology, or marriage and family therapy. Potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas. Applicants with additional addictions licensure (LAC, LCAC) are encouraged to apply, but this is not a requirement.

• Starting wage is \$71,500/year. Applicants willing to provide dual-diagnosis services could receive an additional increase of \$2,000. Sign-on bonus available. (Full-Time)

Patient Navigator- Primary Care Integration Specialist-

This position is responsible for establishing and maintaining referral relationships with primary care and other healthcare providers. This includes establishment of referral and follow-up protocol and exchange of meaningful healthcare information, management of grant project data and completion of all required activities to maintain grant funding based on CCBHC criteria (Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic).

This requires both interpersonal and data management skills. The patient navigator assures that patients are connected with the right programs and services and seeks to close referral gaps that patients may encounter while receiving care in the CCBHC clinic. The patient navigator must be able to work collaboratively with clients, families, internal programs, external providers, and all aspects of the CCBHC network. The patient navigator must be an outcome focused individual that seeks to help clients have an effective and efficient experience while receiving care. This position is geared towards increasing access to and improving the quality of community mental health and substance use disorder services in pursuit of healthier communities. A Bachelor's degree in healthcare or human services field, Registered Nurse, or a minimum of 4 years practice as a case manager or care coordinator in healthcare setting is required.

• Starting wage is \$21.15/hour. (Full-Time)

Certified Parent Peer Support-

This position consists of helping parent's access new resources and practice new skills in the community for their children. Assist parent with education in identifying and effectively managing or avoiding identified precursors or triggers that result in functional impairments with their child. Applicants must have a High School Diploma or GED and meets definitions of lived experience/active recovery defined by State of Kansas qualifications for Certified Parent Peer Support. Selected applicant will receive training and support in becoming certified through the State of Kansas.

• Starting wage is \$15.71/hour. (Full-Time with some weekend hours expected).

Crisis Support Specialist-

This position works directly with our patients in the roles of observation and transportation. Must be able to demonstrate interpersonal skills, have the ability to work with persons with mental and/or physical impairments, and possess the ability to react effectively in a wide variety of human service situations.

• Starting wage is: \$16.39/hour. Hours for this position are part-time prn (as needed). Independence has a part-time insurance eligible shifts with set hours of 10:00am-5:00pm or 5:00pm-Midnight available.

Quest Summer Program Aides-

These positions consist of providing supervision, structure and safety to child patients enrolled in the Quest-Foundations Summer Program. Applicants must demonstrate an ability to engage with children ages 5-21 in various recreational and outdoor settings with a consistent high level of energy while teaching pro-social skills. Applicants must have a high school diploma (or equivalent) and be 18 on or before May 31st, 2025.

• Starting salary is \$15.40 per hour.

Summer Quest Drivers-

Staff hired for this position work to safely transport children and staff to and from their home, our programming facilities and within the community. The program runs May-August 2023, Monday through Thursday 8am-4pm. Must have high school diploma or GED and valid license with good driving record.

• Starting wage is \$15.40/hour. (Temporary Summer Positions)

Senior System Administrator-

This position consist of providing support monitoring to the performance of servers, software, and network equipment. Diagnosing and troubleshooting technical issues. Configuring and upgrading internal systems and servers as necessary. Managing Active Directory and permissions of user accounts for new and current employees. Management of Phone Systems including VoIP and Legacy phone systems. Applicant must have a Bachelor's degree in Information System Technologies or related field with a minimum of three years of experience in a network environment, or an Associate degree with a minimum of five years of experience in a network environment.

• Starting salary is \$30.80 per hour/\$64,060.00 per year. (Full-Time)

Quest Psychosocial Aide-

This position consists of providing one on one and group settings with children and youth who have been diagnosed with Severe Emotional Disturbance assisting in developing pro-social skills necessary to function and maintain on their own in the home, community and educational settings. Applicants must have a high school diploma (or equivalent) and be at least 18 years old.

• Starting salary is \$15.71/hour. Part-Time (Cowley)

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
