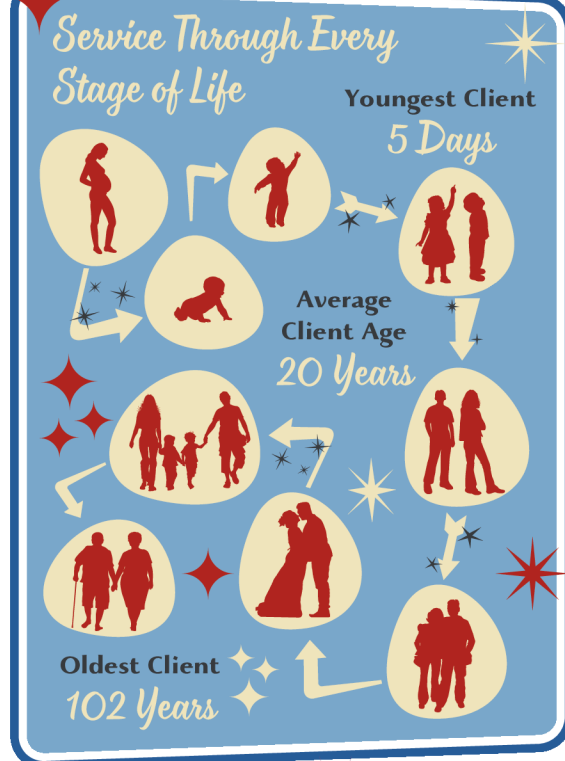

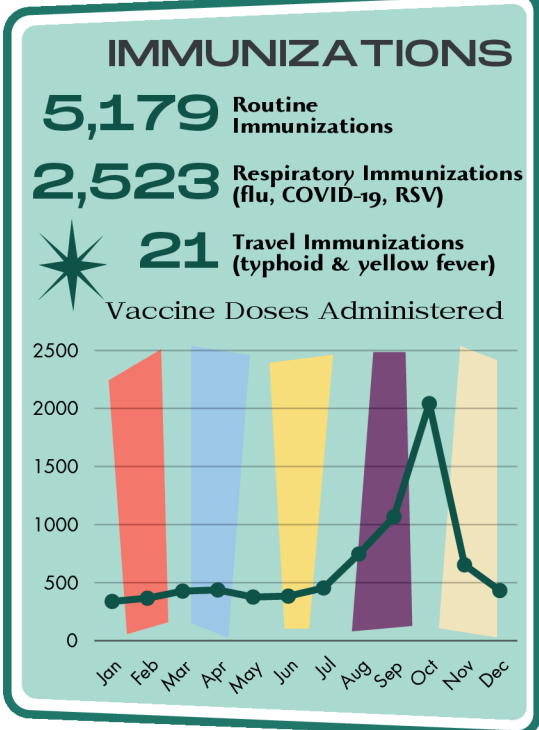

Our presumptive eligibility (PE) team conducts screenings to identify individuals without health insurance coverage who are likely to qualify for Medicaid or CHIP.

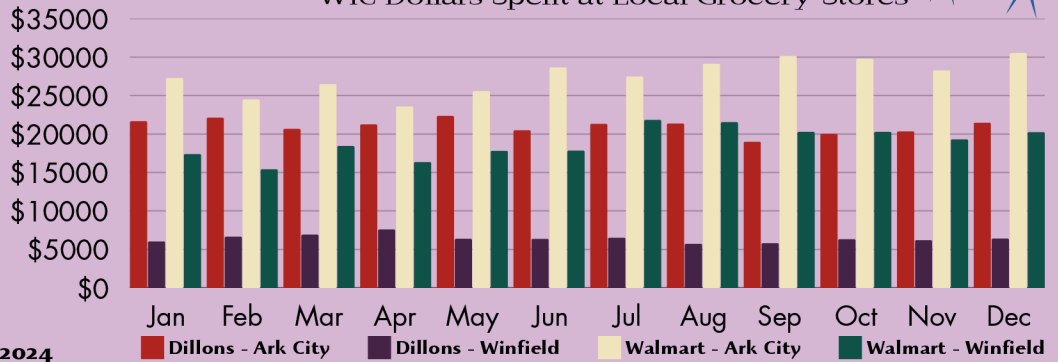

WIC Dollars Spent at Local Grocery Stores



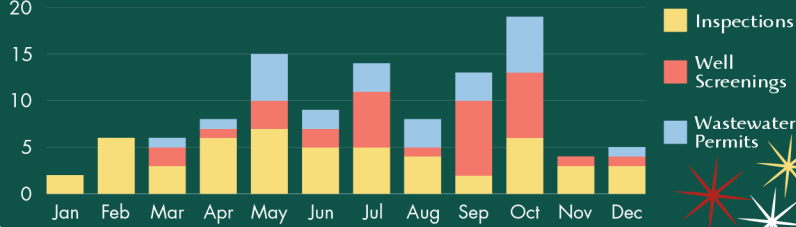

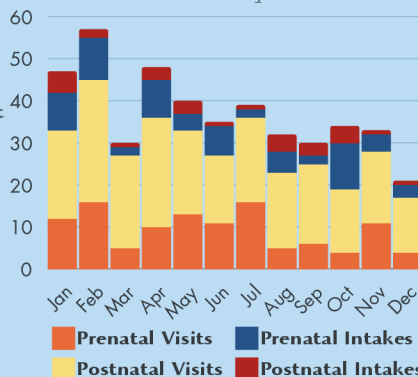
