STAY AWAY!

The best way to prevent rabies is to avoid it entirely! So, keep your distance from any unfamiliar animals.

CALL THE PROFESSIONALS

Animal control officers are better equipped to handle the situation, so don't hesitate to call!

CONTACT YOUR HEALTHCARE PROVIDER

If you think exposure has occurred, then contact your healthcare provider who can recommend the next steps to take, including post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP).
