Winfield Police Department Designees inspect ONLY the following:

- Boat Trailers

- Enclosed trailers

- Bus/ Transport Vans

- Semi Tractors & Trailers

- Passenger Cars/Trucks/SUV
- Livestock trailers
- RV/Campers/Motor Home
- Motorcycle/Moped/ Scooter
- In Cowley County, these inspections are on Tues & Thurs 11 am-1pm at Barn 4 at the Fairgrounds. **\$20 per inspection Cash Only. No appointment required.**

Kansas Highway Patrol – Appointment Required after June 12, 2024

ONLY Troopers can inspect the following:

- Salvage Or Rebuilt Title
- Offroad or off highway vehicles
- Bill of Sale purchases
- No VIN plate or label
- Homemade Trailers

Fee is \$25 per inspection. Located at the KDOT building west of Winfield on Wednesdays from 10:30 a.m. – Noon. Or at 1900 Tigua St in Kechi, Ks M-F 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. * Make an Appointment online at kansashighwaypatrol.gov

What if I don't have the title yet?

Contact your lien holder or dealership to fax a copy (front and back) to the tag office 620-221-5497. Pick up the copy and take it to the inspection location.

What if I don't have a tag to drive it?

Haul the vehicle on a trailer to the inspection location.

Get a 1-day tag using the title at the Tag office to legally drive the vehicle to the location.
